




















### Bramham



## Pembroke


The modern classic. Pembroke is a premium shaker style kitchen that blends traditional style with a contemporary twist centred around the stunning visible woodgrain running through solid ash.

The perfect middle-ground for creating a kitchen that balances traditional design with a contemporary aesthetic, Pembroke cabinetry features flush joints for a more minimal finish.

Combine heritage colours like dark green or navy blue on an island, with a lighter palette across the perimeter cabinetry to create a truly stunning space.







Pembroke is sympathetic to the architecture and features of our renovated farmhouse, while bringing a delightfully contemporary twist to the space. The wood grain through the cabinetry is beautiful and the Forest Green and Putty combination sets off our exposed stonework perfectly.

### Linton

Stylish yet subtle, Linton is a contemporary take on shaker style cabinetry that perfectly blends modern design with traditional features.





















## Grassington



## Meltham



Contemporary, urban and with a slightly industrial vibe, Renzo is a kitchen with a conscience.





## Salcombe


Salcombe's calm and contemporary style is inspired by the great British coastline and days at the beach collecting driftwood and watching the sea lap against the shore.
